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CHILDREN'S AFFINITY TOWARD NATURE

One of the educationalists whom I met recently told me that children who come from rural areas are more talented, creative, and gifted. Rural children are able to climb trees, swim, and jump into any pond, pool, or lake without fear. They would be able to identify trees and plants. They adventure into forgotten woodlands, empty fields, and plots of trees and gardens. They value the marvel of God's creation and have a close harmony with nature. They are the inventors of new games and unorganized outdoor games accelerate their interest in nature and the environment. They are physically, psychologically, and emotionally balanced, because they have a strong affinity with nature. Children raised in the city do not get to experience the beautiful elements of nature. They are caged birds unable to fly in the realm of reality. Electronic gadgets, like mobile devices and computers, harm children and take them away from the world of creation. These kinds of children are at risk of social insecurity, fear, anxiety, and stress in their everyday lives.

Children are fascinated by nature and love nature. They love animals and birds and marvel at the beauty of creation over adults. They have a heightened sensibility



for nature and acquire a natural intelligence.

Kelley says, "People who excel in naturalist intelligence are generally interested in cultivating plants, caring for animals, or studying animals and plants."

Gardener notes, "Such persons with a high degree of naturalist intelligence are keenly aware of how to distinguish the diverse plants, animals, mountains or cloud configuration in their ecological niche'. Unfortunately, as the world becomes more and more urban, the association of the child with nature drastically decreases and the functioning of a harmonious relationship is at stake. It also stated that 85% of the population will be living in cities by 2050 which will lead to children being unable to spend adequate time with nature. The kids would be addicted to YouTube, Instagram, and Twitter would disassociate children from nature.

In an article titled "What Can I Teach My Young Child about the Environment" the US Department of Education claims that because of indoor activities like watching television and playing computer games, society has lost contact with nature: 'The result is that many young children are at risk of never developing positive attitudes and feelings towards the natural environment or never achieving a healthy degree of familiarity with their environment. The focus on environmental education at the early childhood level is a partial antidote to that concern."

Urbanisation is essential to the growth and development of the nation, but not at the expense of making nature vulnerable. City children living on concrete surfaces should experience the elements of reality that are present on natural surfaces. The student community must respond to this serious concern in order to reinforce the links between children and nature. The introduction of environmental education alone is not sufficient to restore their affinity with nature, nor to hold them accountable for the promotion of nature.

The environmental atmosphere created to experience the spirit of nature would be enough for children to be related to nature. Children should be approached to play other games rather than indoor games on mobiles and other electronic devices. E-campus makes it possible for children to feel more connected to nature.

Environmental education shouldn't be an academic subject to be learned for marks or laboratory to experiment instead spends adequate time entertaining, laughing, interacting, and loving and admiring the beauty of nature.

According to Noel McInnis 'The first law of education to the environment: an experiment is worth 10000 photos'.

It is a frightening danger anticipated by environmentalists, ecologists, and nature lovers that the world may become a concrete jungle filled with palatial buildings, impressive houses, luxurious rooms, etc.

'The beauty of God's creation would remain only in the library to be read and watched on television as it is broadcast.

The thirst to live in the lap of nature becomes only a nightmare. Henceforth, it is a time to provide the best practical environmental education to experience nature's simplicity, softness, and purity, thereby helping children develop a kind of affinity towards nature.

It is the fundamental duty of all citizens to safeguard our environment.



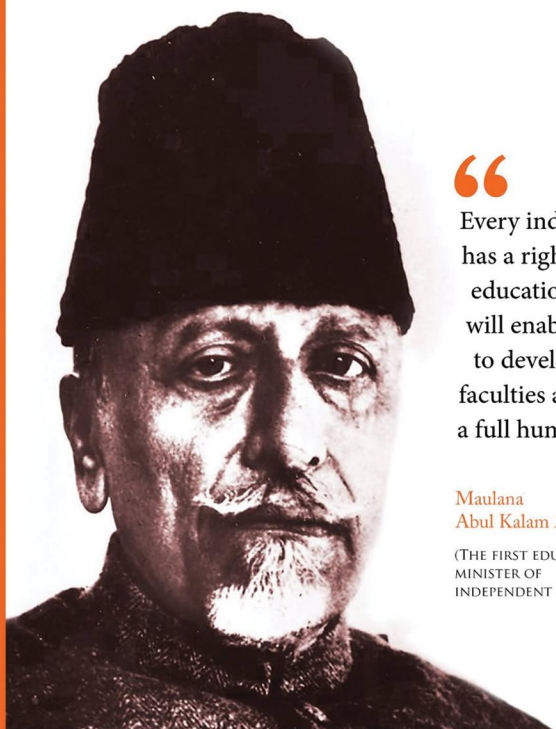

National Education Day of India has been celebrated every year since 2008 on November 11 on the occasion of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad birth anniversary, the first education minister of independent India who served from 15 August 1947 to 2 February 1958. Born in Saudi Arabia in 1888, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad grew up to be one of the leaders of the Indian Independence movement in the late 20th century fighting against British Rule. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad was an avid reader; hence, he began running his own library along with a debating society. He grew to be extensively interested in journalism and started his journey at a very early age. He published his first poetic journal in 1899 with a poem named Nairang-e-Aalam.

Maulana's belief in education was such that he regarded schools as laboratories that can produce the brilliant minds of the future. He even put great emphasis on girls' education and why every woman in our nation needs to be educated for all civil rights. He even introduced vocational training and technical education to the students. The heart of Maulana deeply resided in Education and he wanted India to be a nation that built high educational standards and great legendary minds. For him, education held the utmost importance and he ensured that a uniform

national standard of education was provided across the nation. On 16th January 1948, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad quoted "We must not for a moment forget, it is a birthright of every individual to receive at least the basic education without which he cannot fully discharge his duties as a citizen." Post his election as India's first Education Minister in 1947, Maulana went ahead to make primary education a free and compulsory citizen right for children up to 14 years of age.

National Education Day embarks on the journey of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad in India. His contribution gives relevant importance today and inspires students nationwide. Azad was among the core founders of Jamia Millia Islamia in Delhi and contributed to the foundation of Indian Institute of Technology campuses across the country. He also paved the way for India's highest education Regulator - University Grants Commission.

His contribution to the education sector is highly appreciated and celebrated in India on November 11 every year. It is said that Azad's efforts made India realize the importance of education and why it is every citizen's basic right. He was referred to as Mir-i-Karawan by Jawaharlal Nehru because of his intellectual skills and outstanding personality.

ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ರಾಜ್ಯದಲ್ಲಿ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವವನ್ನು ನವೆಂಬರ್ 1 ರಂದು ಅತ್ಯಂತ ವಿಜೃಂಭಣೆಯಿಂದ ಆಚರಿಸಲಾಗುತ್ತದೆ. ದಕ್ಷಿಣ ಭಾರತದ ಎಲ್ಲಾ ಕನ್ನಡ ಭಾಷೆ ಮಾತನಾಡುವ ಪ್ರದೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ವಿಲೀನಗೊಳಿಸಿ ರಾಜ್ಯವನ್ನು ರೂಪಿಸಿದ ದಿನವನ್ನು ಕನ್ನಡಿಗರು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ರಾಜ್ಯ ರಚನೆಯ ದಿನವೆಂದು ಆಚರಿಸುತ್ತಾರೆ. ಇದು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಸರ್ಕಾರದಿಂದ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವ ಪ್ರಶಸ್ತಿಗಳ ಗೌರವ ಪಟ್ಟಿಯ ಘೋಷಣೆ ಮತ್ತು ಪ್ರಸ್ತುತಿ, ಸಮುದಾಯ ಉತ್ಸವಗಳು, ಆರ್ಕೆಸ್ಟ್ರಾ, ಕನ್ನಡ ಪುಸ್ತಕ ಬಿಡುಗಡೆ ಮತ್ತು ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಮುಖ್ಯಮಂತ್ರಿ ಮತ್ತು ರಾಜ್ಯಪಾಲರ ಭಾಷಣದೊಂದಿಗೆ ಅಧಿಕೃತ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಧ್ವಜಾರೋಹಣದಿಂದ ಗುರುತಿಸಲ್ಪಟ್ಟಿದೆ.

ವಿಷಯ ವಿವರಣೆ:

ಆಲೂರು ವೆಂಕಟರಾವ್ ಅವರು 1905 ರಲ್ಲಿಯೇ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಏಕೀಕರಣ ಚಳುವಳಿಯೊಂದಿಗೆ ರಾಜ್ಯವನ್ನು ಏಕೀಕರಿಸುವ ಕನಸು ಕಂಡ ಮೊದಲ ವ್ಯಕ್ತಿ. 1950 ರಲ್ಲಿ ಭಾರತವು ಗಣರಾಜ್ಯವಾಯಿತು. ಮತ್ತು ನಿರ್ದಿಷ್ಟ ಪ್ರದೇಶದಲ್ಲಿ ಮಾತನಾಡುವ ಭಾಷೆಯ ಆಧಾರದ ಮೇಲೆ ದೇಶದಲ್ಲಿ ವಿವಿಧ ಪ್ರಾಂತ್ಯಗಳನ್ನು ರಚಿಸಲಾಯಿತು. ಮತ್ತು ಇದು ದಕ್ಷಿಣ ಭಾರತದ ವಿವಿಧ ಸ್ಥಳಗಳನ್ನು ಒಳಗೊಂಡಂತೆ ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯಕ್ಕೆ ಜನ್ಮ ನೀಡಿತು. ಇದನ್ನು ಮೊದಲು ರಾಜರು ಆಳಿದರು.

1 ನವೆಂಬರ್ 1956 ರಂದು , ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯವು , ಹಿಂದಿನ ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯವು ಬಹುಪಾಲು ಪ್ರದೇಶವನ್ನು ಒಳಗೊಂಡಿತ್ತು. ಬಾಂಬೆ ಮತ್ತು ಮದ್ರಾಸ್ ಪ್ರೆಸಿಡೆನ್ಸಿಗಳ ಕನ್ನಡ ಮಾತನಾಡುವ ಪ್ರದೇಶಗಳೊಂದಿಗೆ ವಿಲೀನಗೊಂಡಿತು. ಮತ್ತು ಹೈದ್ರಾಬಾದ್ ಸಂಸ್ಥಾನದೊಂದಿಗೆ ಏಕೀಕೃತ ಕನ್ನಡವನ್ನು ರಚಿಸಲಾಯಿತು. ಮಾತನಾಡುವ ಉಪರಾಷ್ಟ್ರೀಯ ಘಟಕ, ಉತ್ತರ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ, ಮಲೆನಾಡು(ಕೆನರಾ) ಮತ್ತು ಹಳೆಯ ಮೈಸೂರು ಹೀಗೆ ಹೊಸದಾಗಿ ರೂಪಗೊಂಡ ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಮೂರು ಪ್ರದೇಶಗಳಾಗಿವೆ.

ಹೊಸದಾಗಿ ಏಕೀಕೃತ ರಾಜ್ಯವು ಆರಂಭದಲ್ಲಿ “ಮೈಸೂರು” ಎಂಬ ಹೆಸರನ್ನು ಉಳಿಸಿಕೊಂಡಿತು. ಇದು ಹೊಸ ಘಟಕದ ತಿರುಳನ್ನು ರೂಪಿಸಿದ ಹಿಂದಿನ ರಾಜಪ್ರಭುತ್ವದ ರಾಜ್ಯವಾಗಿತ್ತು. ಆದರೆ ಉತ್ತರ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದ ಜನರು ಮೈಸೂರು ಎಂಬ ಹೆಸರನ್ನು ಉಳಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳಲು ಒಲವು ತೋರಲಿಲ್ಲ. ಏಕೆಂದರೆ ಇದು ಹಿಂದಿನ ಪ್ರಭುತ್ವ ಮತ್ತು ಹೊಸ ರಾಜ್ಯದ ದಕ್ಷಿಣ ಪ್ರದೇಶಗಳೊಂದಿಗೆ ನಿಕಟ ಸಂಬಂಧ ಹೊಂದಿತ್ತು. ಈ ತರ್ಕಕ್ಕೆ ಬದ್ಧವಾಗಿ , 1 ನವೆಂಬರ್ 1973 ರಂದು ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಹೆಸರನ್ನು “ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ” ಎಂದು ಬದಲಾಯಿಸಲಾಯಿತು. ಈ ಮಹತ್ವದ ನಿರ್ಧಾರವನ್ನು ತೆಗೆದುಕೊಂಡಾಗ ದೇವರಾಜ್ ಅರಸು ಅವರು ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಮುಖ್ಯಮಂತ್ರಿಯಾಗಿದ್ದರು. ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದ ಏಕೀಕರಣಕ್ಕೆ ಮನ್ನಣೆ ನೀಡಿದ ಇತರ ವ್ಯಕ್ತಿಗಳೆಂದರೆ ಕೆ.ಶಿವರಾಂ ಕಾರಂತ್, ಕುವೆಂಪು, ಮಾಸ್ತಿ ವೆಂಕಟೇಶ ಅಯ್ಯಂಗಾರ್, ವಿ.ಎನ್ ಕೃಷ್ಣರಾವ್ ಮತ್ತು ಜಿ.ಎಂ ಶ್ರೀಕಂಠಯ್ಯ ಅವರಂತಹ ಸಾಹಿತಿಗಳು.

ಕರ್ನಾಟಕವನ್ನು ನಾಲ್ಕು ಭಾಗಗಳಾಗಿ ವಿಂಗಡಿಸಲಾಗಿದೆ. ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯ, ಮುಂಬೈ, ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಹೈದರಾಬಾದ್ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಮತ್ತು ಮದ್ರಾಸ್ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ. ಈ ಎಲ್ಲ ಭಾಗಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಕನ್ನಡ ಮಾತನಾಡುವವರಿಗೆ ಮನ್ನಣೆ ನೀಡಲಾಗಿದೆ. ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಬಹು ಸಂಖ್ಯಾತ ಪ್ರದೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕಕ್ಕೆ ಸೇರಿಸುವ ಪ್ರಕ್ರಿಯೆ ಭರದಿಂದ ಸಾಗಿದೆ. ಸುತ್ತ ಮುತ್ತಲಿನ ರಾಜ್ಯಗಳ ಕನ್ನಡ ರಾಜ್ಯಗಳು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದ ಕಲ್ಲಿ ವಿಲೀನಗೊಂಡವು. ಅಚಿತಿಮವಾಗಿ 1956 ರಲ್ಲಿ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಏಕೀಕರಣವಾಯಿತು. ಕನ್ನಡ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವ ಶುಭ !. ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಹೆಸರು ಮೈಸೂರು ಏಕೆಂದರೆ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಮೊದಲ ಸೃಷ್ಟಿ ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯವನ್ನು ಆಧರಿಸಿತ್ತು. ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯವನ್ನು 1973 ರಲ್ಲಿ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಎಂದು ಮರು ನಾಮಕರಣ ಮಾಡಲಾಯಿತು.

Throughout India cases of young girls going missing are continuously reported. These girls are supposedly lured on the pretext of securing a job or earning money and sent to other states and subsequently forced into prostitution.

Solutions and Preventive Measures

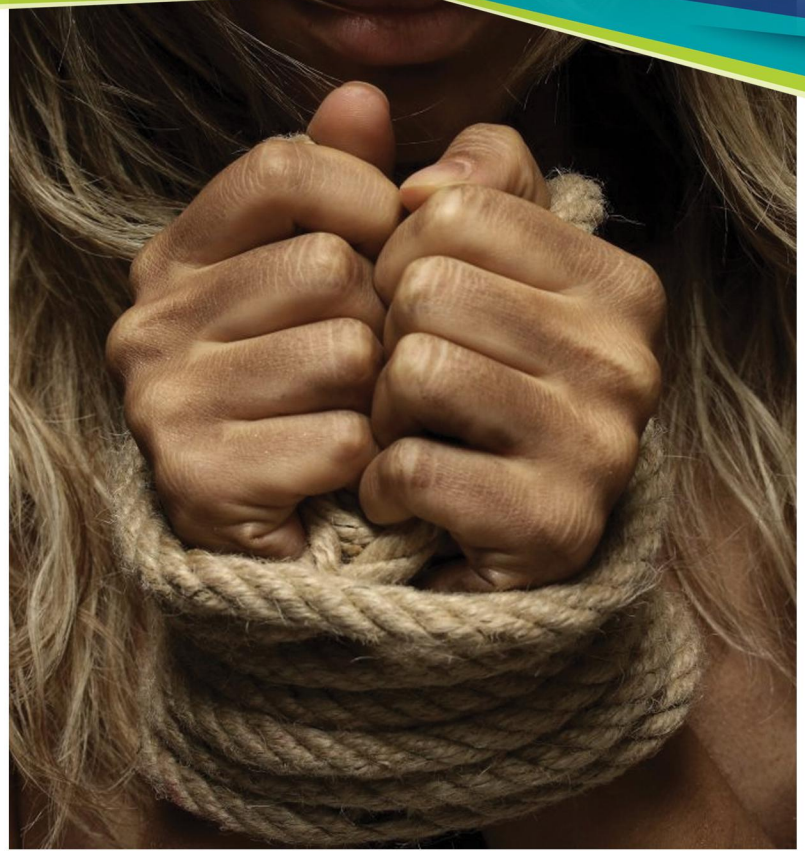
Where there is a problem there would be a solution too, here, I would like to bring out some solutions to women's violence.

Increased Police Vigil

Police vigil must be increased in all areas, especially in the secluded areas during the night. Police presence significantly reduces the chance of a woman getting assaulted or harassed by others on the road. Police officers must be deployed at crowded places like markets, as the women at these places are more susceptible to crimes like eve-teasing or groping.

Community Initiative

Initiatives taken by the community itself toward curbing violence against women are the best way to



counter domestic violence and as well as other crimes against women. The Nari Adalat program introduced in Uttar Pradesh by the Department of Education has proved instrumental in reducing domestic violence against women.

Safe Transport

Many acts of sexual violence against women are committed on trains or buses mainly during late hours. Offenders take advantage of the secluded vehicle and the absence of police personnel. There is a need to deploy at least one-woman police rail coach during late-night hours.

Conclusion

Violence against Indian women is a blot on the nation and society as well. As long as Indian women are subjected to violence, the international image of India is also going to suffer. Also, incidents of domestic violence, sexual assaults, and other similar crimes against women will continuously damage Indian society and obstructs national progress.
